

**CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS
ORDINANCE NO. 3586**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICES OF APPOINTED CITY OFFICERS FOR
THE FISCAL YEAR OF THE CITY COMMENCING MAY 1, 2021 AND ENDING
APRIL 30, 2022**

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia (“City”), Monroe and St. Clair Counties, Illinois is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinances of the City, and Division 30 of Article 3.1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/3.1-30-5), non-elected City Officers are to be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the City Council.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia as follows:

Section 1. The preceding recitations in the upper part of this Ordinance are realleged, restated and adopted as paragraph one (“1”) of this Ordinance.

Section 2. **Full-Time Appointed City Officers.** The following persons are hereby appointed to fill the following appointed City offices for the one (1) year term beginning May 1, 2021, and ending April 30, 2022:

- Douglas R. Brimm, City Administrator, Budget Officer, Health Officer, and Freedom of Information Act Officer
- Jason P. Donjon, Chief of Police and Director of EMS
- Karla F. Heine, Deputy Chief of Police
- Christopher A. Smith, City Engineer and Director of Public Works
- Justin Osterhage, Building Official

Section 3. **Part-Time Appointed City Officers.** The following persons are hereby appointed to fill the following part-time appointed City offices for the one (1) year term beginning May 1, 2021, and ending April 30, 2022:

- Linda A. Sharp, City Treasurer
- Justin Osterhage, Americans with Disabilities Act Coordinator
- Joshua M. Bayer, Director of EMA
- Randy Rudloff, Plumbing Inspector

Section 4. **Professional Appointed City Officers.** The following professional City Officers are hereby appointed for the one (1) year term beginning May 1, 2021 and ending April 30, 2022:

- City Attorney. The Law Firm of Bruckert, Behme & Long, P.C. is appointed as corporate legal counsel (i.e., City Attorney) for the usual and customary legal services of the City, including preparation and/or review of ordinances and resolutions required for corporate action to be taken by the City, consulting with and rendering legal advice to the Mayor, the City Council, and the other elected and appointed officers of the City on all legal questions affecting the City; for the prosecution or defense of all suits or legal actions in which the City, or any of its Officers, acting in the course and scope of their official duties may be a party (for which a defense is not provided by the City's insurer); negotiations and documentation of routine city financial matters (including lease-purchase agreements and installment sales agreements for the purchase of real or personal property by the City).

Section 5. All ordinances, resolutions, or orders of the City in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Corporate Authorities.
