AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A REPLACEMENT MEMBER TO THE BOARD OF FIRE AND POLICE COMMISSIONERS AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE POLICE PENSION FUND FOR THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, one (1) member of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners, which consists of three (3) members serving three (3) year terms, is appointed by the Mayor each year with the advice and consent of the City Council (65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-1 and Municipal Code Section 2.46.040); and

WHEREAS, Gene Bergmann ("Bergmann") was previously appointed as a member of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners by the Mayor to a term expiring April 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Bergmann has submitted to the City of Columbia ("City") his resignation as a member of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to appoint an individual to fill the vacancy on the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners created by Bergmann's resignation; and

WHEREAS, two (2) of the five (5) members of the Board of Trustees of the Police Pension Fund are appointed by the Mayor to serve for a term of two (2) years, beginning the second Tuesday of May of the year of appointment (40 ILCS 5/3-128 and Municipal Code Section 2.66.030); and

WHEREAS, Bergmann was previously appointed as a member of the Board of Trustees of the Police Pension Fund by the Mayor to a term expiring May 11, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Bergmann has submitted to the City his resignation as a member of the Board of Trustees of the Police Pension Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to appoint an individual to fill the vacancy on the Board of Trustees of the Police Pension Fund created by Bergmann's resignation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1. Board of Fire and Police Commissioners:** Anthony Traxler resides within the corporate limits of the City of Columbia, Illinois and is appointed as a member of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners, replacing Gene Bergmann. Such term is to begin immediately and shall expire on April 30, 2018.

**Section 2. Board of Trustees of the Police Pension Fund:** Al Hudzik resides in the corporate limits of the City of Columbia, Illinois and is appointed to serve as a member of the Columbia Police Pension Fund Board of Trustees, replacing Gene Bergmann. Such term is to begin immediately and shall expire on May 11, 2017.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect, and the appointments made herein shall be effective immediately, from and after its passage as provided by law.

**Section 4.** All Ordinances, Resolutions, or Orders in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.


