

ORDINANCE NO. 3353

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE AN EASEMENT AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS AND ADMIRAL PARKWAY, INC. FOR A BLANKET ACCESS EASEMENT

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate that the City of Columbia, Illinois (the "City") approve an Easement Agreement by and between City Of Columbia, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation (the "Grantee"), and Admiral Parkway, Inc., (the "Grantor"); and

WHEREAS, the Grantee has requested the Grantor provide said easement to and for the benefit of the Grantee which will provide access on the Grantor's Property upon the terms and conditions set forth in said Easement Agreement; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate that the City enact this ordinance to grant and approve the easement with the terms set forth in the Easement Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The recitals contained above in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference, the same as if set forth in this Section of this Ordinance verbatim, as findings of the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois.

Section 2. Attached hereto is the easement agreement by and between City of Columbia, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation (the "Grantee"), and Admiral Parkway, Inc., (the "Grantor"); which is granted and approved by this ordinance. The City hereby approves the form of the attached Easement Agreement and does hereby authorize and direct the Mayor to sign the same.

Section 3. The City Council hereby authorizes and directs the City to record in the office of the Monroe County, Illinois Recorder the fully executed and attested Easements aforesaid and thereafter to file them with the permanent real estate records of the City.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect, from and after its passage, as provided by law.



PERMANENT EASEMENT
(Usage & Maintenance)

THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH THAT, the GRANTOR(S), **Admiral Parkway, Inc.**, Illinois County of Monroe and State of Illinois for and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00), hereby represent that they own the fee simple title to and does by these presents, grant the right, perpetual easement and privilege to enter upon the following described land (Adler Ridge) unto the **City of Columbia**, for the purpose of providing general site access to common property as needed by police, fire, emergency, and utility personnel.

Said tract of land is situated in the County of Monroe, State of Illinois, and is described in the legal description attached, marked as "Exhibit A" and illustrated on "Exhibit B."

BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF COLUMBIA LAKES GAMMA SUBDIVISION, REFERENCE BEING HAD TO THE PLAT THEREOF RECORDED IN THE RECORDER'S OFFICE OF MONROE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN ENVELOPE 158D; THENCE AT AN ASSUMED BEARING OF SOUTH 79°59'55" EAST, ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF COLUMBIA LAKES GAMMA SUBDIVISION, A DISTANCE OF 380.69 FEET TO A CONCRETE MONUMENT FOUND WHICH MARKS THE LAND CONVEYED TO THE CITY OF COLUMBIA BY DEED RECORDED IN THE RECORDER'S OFFICE OF MONROE COUNTY, ILLINOIS IN BOOK OF DEEDS 82 ON PAGE 288; THENCE SOUTH 02°34'45" WEST, ALONG THE WEST LINE OF SAID CITY OF COLUMBIA TRACT, A DISTANCE OF 360.20 FEET TO A PIPE FOUND WHICH MARKS THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF A SECOND TRACT OF LAND CONVEYED TO THE CITY OF COLUMBIA BY DEED RECORDED IN THE RECORDER'S OFFICE OF MONROE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN BOOK OF DEEDS 88 ON PAGE 16; THENCE NORTH 79°13'58" WEST, ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF SAID SECOND CITY OF COLUMBIA TRACT, A DISTANCE OF 124.73 FEET TO A CONCRETE MONUMENT FOUND WHICH MARKS THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SAID SECOND CITY OF COLUMBIA TRACT; THENCE SOUTH 10°34'52" WEST, ALONG THE WEST LINE OF SAID SECOND CITY OF COLUMBIA TRACT, A DISTANCE OF 200.13 FEET TO A CONCRETE MONUMENT FOUND WHICH MARKS THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID SECOND CITY OF COLUMBIA TRACT; THENCE SOUTH 79°33'28" EAST, ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID SECOND CITY OF COLUMBIA TRACT, A DISTANCE OF 124.83 FEET TO A CONCRETE MONUMENT FOUND WHICH MARKS THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SAID SECOND CITY OF COLUMBIA TRACT AND LIES ON THE WEST LINE OF THE AFOREMENTIONED FIRST CITY OF COLUMBIA TRACT, THENCE SOUTH 16°40'35" WEST, ALONG SAID FIRST CITY OF COLUMBIA TRACT, A DISTANCE OF 316.56 FEET TO A CONCRETE MONUMENT FOUND WHICH LIES ON THE EASTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY OF A PUBLIC ROAD KNOWN AS F.A. ROUTE 4 (A.K.A. OLD ROUTE 3), BEING A POINT OF CURVATURE; THENCE ALONG THE EASTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF F.A. ROUTE 4, BEING A CURVE TO THE RIGHT HAVING A RADIUS OF 2,138.68 FEET, A CENTRAL ANGLE OF 26°32'08" AND A CHORD OF 981.66 FEET WHICH BEARS NORTH 17°27'50" WEST, AN ARC LENGTH OF 990.49 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 79°59'55" EAST, ALONG THE NORTHWESTERLY EXTENSION OF THE SOUTH LINE OF COLUMBIA LAKES GAMMA SUBDIVISION, A DISTANCE OF 64.24 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 5.25 ACRES, MORE OR LESS.
