AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF CERTAIN BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF THE CITY COMMENCING MAY 1, 2018 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2019

WHEREAS, each member of the City Zoning Board of Appeals, which shall consist of seven (7) members, shall be appointed for a five (5) year term by the City Council (65 ILCS 5/11-13-3 and Municipal Code Section 17.08.010);

WHEREAS, the nine (9) members of the City Plan Commission are appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, to serve for a term of three (3) years (65 ILCS 5/11-12-4 and Municipal Code Sections 2.32.010 and 2.32.020);

WHEREAS, three (3) of the nine (9) members of the City Library Board of Directors, shall be appointed annually by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council, not more than one (1) of the directors being a member of the City Council, to serve three (3) year terms (75 ILCS 5/4-1 and Municipal Code Sections 2.48.010 and 2.48.020);

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the City shall consist of the Mayor (who shall be Chair thereof), all members of the City Council, the City Clerk (who shall be Secretary thereof), and such other members as the Mayor and City Council shall, from time to time, provide for and appoint (65 ILCS 5-11-16-1 and Municipal Code Section 2.44.010);

WHEREAS, the Director of the Emergency Management Agency of the City shall be appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council (Municipal Code Section 2.62.020);

WHEREAS, the Street Graphics Advisory Committee, which shall consist of seven (7) members, three (3) members to be appointed in even numbered years and four (4) members to be appointed in odd numbered years, shall be appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council, for two (2) year terms (Municipal Code Sections 15.44.340 and 15.44.350);

WHEREAS, the City Electrical Commission shall consist of six (6) members, which shall include the Electrical Inspector as the Ex Officio Chair with the other five (5) members thereof to be appointed for four (4) year terms by the Mayor with the advice and consent the City Council (65 ILCS 5/11-37-2 and Municipal Code Section 15.32.020);

WHEREAS, one (1) member of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners, which consists of three (3) members serving three (3) year terms, shall be appointed by the Mayor each year with the advice and consent of the City Council (65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-1 and Municipal Code Section 2.46.040);

WHEREAS, two (2) of the five (5) members of the Board of Trustees of the Police Pension Fund shall be appointed by the Mayor to serve for a term of two (2) years, beginning the second Tuesday of May of the year of appointment (40 ILCS 5/3-128 and Municipal Code Section 2.66.030);

WHEREAS, by the Historic Site Preservation Ordinance of the City (City Ordinance No. 2483, enacted 8/7/06) the Columbia Heritage and Preservation Commission shall consist of nine (9) voting members who are residents of the City or who own real property in the City, four (4) to be appointed on odd numbered years and five (5) to be appointed on even numbered years, are appointed to two (2) year terms by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council, excepting that the residency requirement may be waived for not more than three (3) members who, in the opinion of the Mayor and the City Council, possess special knowledge or expertise in historic preservation or local history (Municipal Code Sections 15.64.030, 15.64.040 and 15.64.050);

WHEREAS, the Architectural Review Board shall consist of seven (7) members appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council to serve for three (3) year terms (Municipal Code Section 15.66.040);

WHEREAS, the Federal Americans with Disabilities Act ("ADA") (42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.) requires the creation of and appointment of members to a grievance committee for the purpose of hearing appeals rendered by the ADA Coordinator and that said members shall be appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council (Municipal Code Sections 2.64.010 and 2.64.040);

WHEREAS, the Columbia Play Commission consists of nine (9) members appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council, to serve for three (3) year terms, or until their successors are appointed and have been qualified (Resolution No. 02-2009);

WHEREAS, the Tourism Advisory Committee consists of seven (7) voting members appointed annually by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council, to serve for one (1) year terms, or until their successors are appointed and have been qualified (Ordinance No. 2735); and

WHEREAS, the Business Loan Review Committee consists of the City Attorney, the Director of Community and Economic Development, the Mayor and five (5) additional members with financial backgrounds, representing the business community or financial institutions, appointed by the City Council (Ordinance No. 3052); and

WHEREAS, the Wardman Cemetery Board of Managers consists of three (3) members appointed for two (2) year terms by the Mayor and approved by the City Council (Ordinance No. 2789).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Columbia Zoning Board of Appeals: The following persons, who reside within the corporate limits of the City, are appointed as members of the Columbia Zoning Board of Appeals to serve for the following five (5) year terms:


Section 18. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect, and the appointments made herein shall be effective as of the appointment dates shown hereon, from and after its passage as provided by law.
